Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Feldpausch at 2:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of Meetings –March 9 & March 30, 2026 ***A motion was made by E. Douglass supported by K. Halfmann to approve the minutes from the March 9 2026 regular monthly board meeting and March 30, 2026 Budget meeting. Motion carried.***

Approval of Bills: ***A motion was made by E. Douglas , supported by K. Halfmann to approve the payment of the monthly bills totaling \$7718.24 in General Fund and \$1599.83 in Fire Department and any other regular bills received prior to next meeting. Motion carried.***

Reports

Fire Dept: Chief Feldpausch reported that he is working on pager replacement to coordinate with the county. Three weather siren tests are scheduled in May (deferred from April when there was inclement weather). He is working on trading in used airpaks and canisters. We are coordinating with SJFD on a county-wide grant for turnout gear. Researching replacing old jaws of life with a combo jaws/cutter. He will bring more information to the May Meeting. The department ended 25/26 with 109 calls.

Clerk: Clerk Schafer shared that she has been working on year-end tasks, including budgeting and insurance renewals. She has also been working with the accountant to rectify an error with the 941 to correct funds that the IRS attributed to the wrong quarter.

Treasurer: K. Halfmann requested that newsletter items be given to her by the May meeting. She shared that two of the CDs are up for renewal in the next couple of months.

Supervisor: V. Feldpausch shared that he has heard a couple of residents' concerns about gravel. He is working on a Grange Rd land division. CCRC contracts will be discussed later in the meeting. Bill Irrer will be contributing \$4400 spot gravel on his truck route. One BOR appeal that resulted in a lowering and PPE appeal.

Village of Fowler Parks Grant-Clerk Schafer presented a letter drafted in support of the Village of Fowler pursuing a grant for parks improvement within the village. ***A motion was made by E. Douglass, supported by K. Halfmann to approve the letter to be submitted to Rhonda Feldpausch, Village Clerk. Motion carried.***

Resolution Authorizing Continued use of the MABAS Alarm System for Fire Services-Clerk Schafer presented a formal resolution to enable the Fire Department to continue its use of the MABAS Alarm System.***A motion was made by E.
