Approval of Bills: ***A motion was made by E. Douglass, supported by V. Feldpausch to approve the payment of the monthly bills, including the addition of the invoice from Scott Schneider for hall painting in the amount of \$2025.00, totaling \$24,658.60 in General Fund bills, \$3499.69 in Fire Department and any other regular bills received prior to next meeting. Reports

Fire Dept–Chief Feldpausch shared the they have responded to 35 calls to date. He has an interview next week with a prospective hire. He is working on a quote to for spare air tanks. The new mutual assistance devices have been set up. Dallas Township will provide aid for structure fires in St. Johns.

Clerk–Clerk Schafer reported that she has is continuing to work on the PA116 received last month. There was an error in the parcel numbers that was corrected by the applicant. It has been sent to county officials for comment before being sent to the state for final approval. She shared that the county DWM is again asking for a letter of support. Due to the current discussions, the board opted to hold off.

Treasurer–Treasurer Halfmann suggested that we renew our Union Bank CD from 15 months to 12 months to earn a higher interest rate. She will be meeting with the accountant later this month. Summer tax collection has begun.

A motion was made by V. Feldpausch, supported by E. Douglass to renew the Union Bank CD for the length of 12 months. Motion carried.

Supervisor-Supervisor Fedpausch worked with a resident to resolve a FEMA complaint that an outbuilding was constructed on a flood plain. He also worked on a Land Division. The paperwork to receive reimbursement via the 2024/25 DNR grant has been filed. He has also completed the application to receive the grant for 2025/26.

New Business

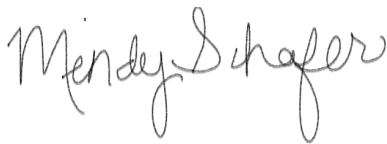
