Because we do not have a police department, we will likely be able to keep 25% and donate the remaining to Clinton County Sheriff Dept.

Supervisor: V. Feldpausch shared that a non-conforming land division was approved because it resulted in a conforming land division. The grant that he was hopeful could be filed with SJFD must be single entity only, so he and C. Bongard will begin working on it.
